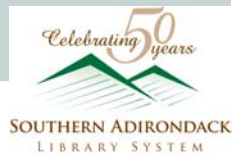

MAKE A SPLASH WITH OUR SUMMER READING PROGRAMS

Summer Reading Club K-6 Grade

When registering, students will receive a reading record, a bag to keep their books in and a bookmark. Students are asked to read at least 6 books at their reading level over the summer. After reading 6 books students may sign up for the Summer Reading Club Party on August 31 at 12:30pm. Once a week students may update their reading records at either branch of the Round Lake Library. They may enter their name into our Reading Club Raffle and pick a small prize.

"Read to Me" Club for Young Readers and a Partner

Young readers can keep a reading log of books that are read to them over the summer. For every 3 books read you may enter our "Read to Me" raffle for a family prize. The "Read to Me" Club may also attend our Summer Rock 'N Read party at the end of the summer with Andy the Music Man.

Friday, July 16 at 5:30pm at Clark House

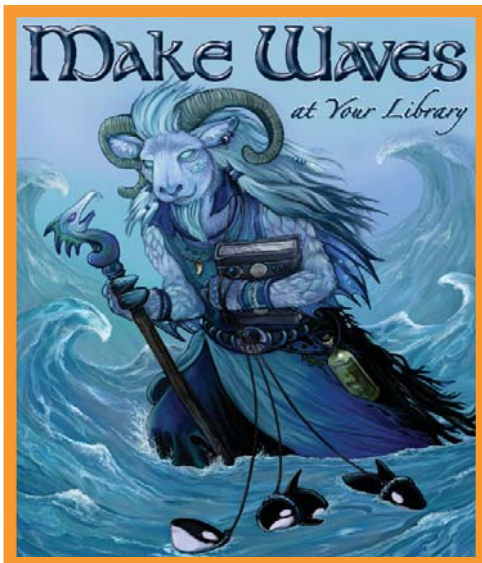
We had so much fun, we're going to keep doing it!

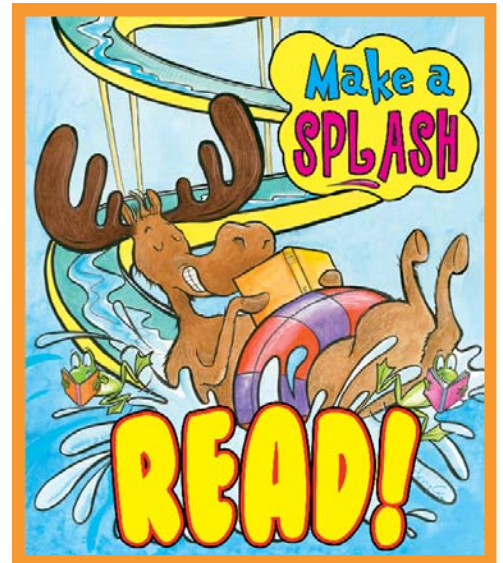
Please join us for a pot luck supper and a viewing and discussion of the classic film *To Kill A Mockingbird*, starring Gregory Peck.

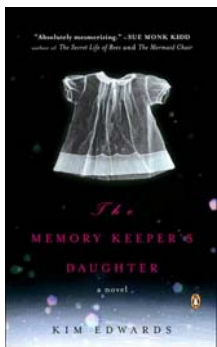

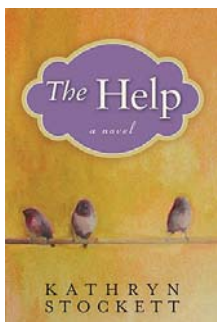
